Project - Milton Road Community Centre

Work was issued by Haringey Home and Building Services to completely redesign and construct a new single-storey extension to an existing community centre. Specific instructions were to use traditional double skin brick work, in-facing bricks on the outer skin and solar block work on the inner skin. The roof was to comprise flat area over office and ancillary middle section and pitched over the multi-purpose hall to match existing roof.

Other works include double glazed doors and windows, internal walls, internal doors, floor, wall and ceiling finishing's, decorations, fittings and fixtures, sanitary appliances, mechanical and electrical installation, drainage; complete with powder coated steel roller shutter doors.



Project - Claire Road

Carried out a complete refurbishment of a 3 bed roomed house in East London for Waltham Forest Council. Fitted a new shower wet room, new kitchen, roof, new guttering and drainage, installed new central heating system, re-wired complete property, re-plastered, new double glazed windows and doors, landscaped front and rear gardens, decorations and floor coverings. Job was completed within the ten week period allowed and all handed over to the client who was very happy with the standard of work.

Project - Brettenham Primary School Courtyard

Work was issued by London Borough of Enfield for Brettenham Primary School, the work was to take up old paving to courtyard and supply and install new paving with circular water feature with bamboo style railed fence. Install raised flower beds, pegola and assessed by paved paths and ramp.

This was a touch and feel garden for a partially blind student of the school.

Project - Edmonton County School Sixth Form Area

Edmonton County School wanted us to create a new sixth form area for their students, working with the school we were able to design and create this retro styled American diner where the students are able to study, sit and relax, and make drinks & refreshments. The project was a complete refurbishment including a new kitchen with an instant hot tap, new natural wood flooring, painting and decorating and fittings and furnishings.



Project - South Haringey Children's Centre

Issued by Faithorn Farrell Timms LLP for London Borough of Haringey we were instructed to provide an installation of a temporary classroom with access ramps and steps. Installation of new timber steps and landing and railings/fencing. Provided minor, electrical and mechanical works and provision of a storage container for children's play equipment.

All works were completed within the six week school holidays, and was completed within the agreed time scale.



Project - Stationers Park, Muswell Hill

We were asked by our client Haringey Council to repair the river bank that had collapsed.

As the river was set at different levels throughout the park we managed to dam the river, pump out the lower section, concrete in new timber sleepers as support walls and dig out collapsed spoil and fill in behind new timbers.

We than landscaped the river bank back to it original detail, removed the dams and re-filled the river back to its original depth.

The works took 4 weeks to complete and the value of works was £28,000.00. The pictures are of a garden we created at Capel Manor College, which is one of a number we have built for them at their garden centre in Enfield.



Project - Lordship Lane Park, Tottenham

The pictures are the works we carried out in the Lordship Recreation Park in Tottenham. We created a new disabled access path around the lake which was finished with a stone resin path. We also built up the sides of the lake replacing the perished brick coping with black engineering bricks. The work took 6 weeks to complete and the cost of the works was £32.400.00.







Project - Smokers Garden at Capel Manor College

The pictures below are of the garden we created at Capel Manor College. We were given a design plan by the client.

The existing old garden was taken out, ground levelled to suit paths, footings and concrete seating built. Half circular paviours laid to create design with new Breedan Gravel laid and consolidated with machine roller. Bespoke fencing fabricated on site. Works took 4 weeks and cost £12,000.00.











R D Bull & Sons work on numerous private residential properties every year, building extensions, loft conversions, refurbishments, conservation works, new roofs, windows, driveway's and all other maintenance work. The project pictures you see here is one of our extensions completed at 16 Highworth Road, N11. We opened out the rear of the house and installed structural steel work supporting the upper two floors. Installed new aluminium folding doors, roof lights, new kitchen and utility room. We also build decking area to the rear garden and concreted the shared side access on completion.




Project - 16 Highworth Road

Prior to starting number 16 Highworth Road, we negotiated a price to build an identical extension to their neighbour's property at the same time. This included a new kitchen and dining room area with a separate utility room. Slightly different design as you will see from the photographs. on the next page. Both projects were completed within programme. 16 Highworth Road was managed by Toca Architect Services, who the client employed to do the design and get planning approval.







Project - 14 Highworth Road

Instructed by client's architect to extend the rear side of the house, this made the room larger for an open plan kitchen and dining room. We structurally supported the first floor rear edition and removed all ground floor walls. New structural beams were manufactured and installed. New foundations and brick work to match existing was built extending the rear edition out to the flank wall. New tiled roof with velux windows and new folding oak doors were installed. Painted and decorated, laundry room added and new kitchen units and appliances fitted.

Our client Springboard Housing Association awarded us the contract to take out all the baths in each of the old people's flats at Fitzwilliam Court in Harlow. We supplied and fitted level access shower trays with pumped wastes, new showers, tiling and safety vinyl floor coverings, decorations and all associated wiring.

The project was a 6 week contract period and we completed all the works on time, fitting 24no wet rooms in total.




Project - Stockfield Avenue, Hoddesdon

Broxbourne Housing Associations needed an extension and conversion for one of their residents who has a disabled child. The plan was to extend the back and the side of the house to create easy access and more room for their disabled child. We created a ground floor bedroom with wet room bathing facilities, new kitchen, dining room, ramp accesses to front and side elevations with remote controlled door access equipment. New windows and doors were installed, gas, heat and electrics were installed and all rooms painted and decorated.









Project - Oliver Reginald Tambo Memorial

A bust of Mr Tambo by Ian Walters was unveiled at Albert Road Recreation Ground, N22, by Haringey Council Leader, Cllr George Meehan, along with the Secretary of State for Justice, Jack Straw and the First Lady of South Africa Mrs Zanele Mbeki. The event was organised by Haringey Council in partnership with the South African High Commission, the Friends of Albert Road Recreation Ground (FARRG), Alexandra Park Secondary School and Rhodes Avenue Primary School, to celebrate the borough's association with Mr Tambo, who was President of the ANC from 1967 to 1991.
